

## Youth Facility Rules

By signing the parent code of conduct my family and I (along with our guest) agree to follow these rules:

1. No drugs, alcohol or tobacco is permitted on school campuses or at sites where youth sports are being played.
2. Please stay off the football sleds and football bars at Coast Union High School.
3. Please pick up all trash from game locations and either put in an available trash can or completely remove from site.
4. Dogs are not permitted on school campuses or at any game locations.
5. Please make sure your child's coach is present before you drop your child off for games or practices. Children may not be left on campus to wait for practice. (Make sure all after school programs have been made aware of whom your child's coach is and when practices will be held so they are aware of your soccer schedule.)
6. Please promptly pick your child up at game and practice end times. Players may not be left unattended after soccer practice with no coach or parent, even if they have a sibling practicing somewhere on the campus. We could lose field privileges for this. Remember your coaches are volunteers, have respect for their time.
7. Please keep small children off the field during games at all locations.
8. If you see problems with the fields or facilities please let a CYAA Volunteer or location staff know as soon as possible.
9. Do not stand behind the goal area during games.
